- To Begin tending my plot by June 1st.
- To Remove temporary structures and put my plot(s) to bed by the end of the growing season (Nov. 15th.)
- To Complete 100% of my work hours by November 1st.*
- To Attend an orientation session at the start of the season.

My Plot

- To use only organic soil amendments and ecologically sound pest controls.
- To keep weeds under control in my plot and keep them from going to seed.
- To keep paths surrounding my plot(s) clear and properly maintained.
- Keep my plants out of the paths.
- To plant so that sunflowers and other tall plants won't shade another's plot.

Garden Membership

- To respect my neighbors' plot(s) and not pick, plant, or weed without explicit permission. •
- In the event of extenuating circumstances to communicate with a Garden Steward. •
- To record my work hours in a timely fashion.
